- 8 Laptop Computers were given for the Young Women's Training Lab
- 1 Computer Teacher was also provided
- 8 Widows with 52 children joined Incubator Business Training
- 14 Nomadic Students receive scholarships
- 25 Women in Agriculture Initiative benefitted from trees, goats and chickens
- 300 Haitian Students received scholarships and food
- 50 South Asian families receive water, hygiene and covid information
- 60 EQ families were gifted emergency funds
- 70 Women received a loan from the parent's savings program.
- 80 New women received \$90 loan.
- 150 Women were hosted at the Leve Kanpe Conference at the beach
- 300 New women started the microloan training
- 360 Water Filters bring good health to 360 homes
- 400 Women graduated from the microloan program
- 500 EQ Families received filter buckets and maintenance training
- 1500 parents in 3 communities were trained in Hygiene and Clean Water
- The Ford-150 Truck was finally delivered into Cap Haitien. (Note: Haiti does not have gasoline so the water drilling has been stalled)
- Wings for Women Business expanded to recycled/restyled clothing
- Haitian partners traveled to Les Cayes to serve the Earthquake families
- Mission World participated with Catholic Charities to love unaccompanied children in Dallas. We connected with other organizations and shared 5000 Healing Trauma Coloring Books.
