<p>Hours Per week: Part-time (up to 29 hrs/wk); temp/seasonal; as needed. Occasional 30+ hrs/wk or overtime may be approved during busy seasons.</p> <p>Varies depending on need from Mission Waco and availability of the staff member(s). Schedule will vary depending on group schedules -- weekday, weeknights, weekends. Some are one-day or part-day events throughout the year. Others are multi-day -- generally during February, March, late May, June, July, early August. More than one person may be hired to cover needs.</p>	
<p>General Summary: Mission Waco hosts visiting work groups (children, youth, college, adults) who either come for one-day projects or stay in the dorm for "work weeks". Our program goal is to "mobilize" these groups to grow in their desire for, and practice of, a compassionate response in the name of Jesus to the needs of the poor in their lives and churches. This is done through the venue of service projects, relational encounters, and learning opportunities.</p>	
Critical Functions and Responsibilities	
1. Be on-time or early for assigned and agreed-upon shifts.	
2. Good, clear communication with visiting groups. Including being willing to talk about why various projects or activities connect with mission statement of Mission Waco Mission World. And when appropriate, engaging with group members about how those initiatives might connect back in their local setting.	
3. Be a helpful team member. There are many details that go in to hosting groups, so everyone on the team will need to be flexible and willing to help where needed.	
Additional Functions and Responsibilities	
1. May be assigned to help prepare for group projects or details, which involves purchasing or moving supplies to various sites, picking up/delivering food, clean up, etc.	
2. Assist/ manage volunteers at service projects and/or kid's camps.
