## HOW TO REGISTER

- We will send an email within 2-3 business days following up on your inquiry.
- Please pay 24 hours before your program begins. Each time slot is first come, first served. In the case of multiple inquiries for the same time slot, we will ask for you to secure your program through payment.
- In the case of inclement weather, we will either restructure the program, reschedule, or send you a refund.

- Most of our programs can be tailored to groups of any age. However, if you have a group of grade-school students, we ask that you send 1 adult for every 10 students.
- We are in an outdoor setting, so please dress accordingly. We will have water available, but we encourage you to bring your own water as well!
- In the case of inclement weather, we will either reschedule or refund
- We request a minimum of 5 participants for any program.
