Varies depending on need from Mission Waco and availability of the staff member(s). Schedule will vary depending on group schedules weekday, weeknights, weekends. Some are one-day or part-day events throughout the year. Others are multi-day generally during February, March, late May, June, July, early August. More than one person may be hired to cover needs.				
<b>General Summary:</b> Mission Waco hosts visiting volunteer groups of all ages who either come for one-day projects or stay in the dorm for "work weeks". Our program goal is to mobilize these groups to become more compassionately involved with people experiencing poverty. This is done through service projects, relational encounters, and learning opportunities.

And when appropriate, engaging with group members about how those initiatives might connect back in their local setting.</li> </ol>

3. Be a helpful team member. There are many details that go in to hosting groups, so everyone on the team will need to be flexible and willing to help where needed.
