<b>General Summary:</b> Mission Waco hosts visiting volunteer groups of all ages who either come for one-day projects or stay in the dorm for "work weeks". Our program goal is to mobilize these groups to become more compassionately involved with people experiencing poverty. This is done through service projects, relational encounters, and learning opportunities.	
<b>Critical Functions and Responsibilities</b>	
1. Be relational! Good, clear communication with visiting groups. Including being willing to talk about why various projects or activities connect with mission statement of Mission Waco Mission World. And when appropriate, engaging with group members about how those initiatives might connect back in their local setting.	
2. Be punctual and reliable.	
3. Be a helpful team member. There are many details that go in to hosting groups, so everyone on the team will need to be flexible and willing to help where needed.	
4. Manage risk at service opportunities. Communicate expectations and rules to volunteers. Address risky or dangerous behaviors in real time to prevent injury or harm.

1. May be assigned to help prepare for group projects or details, which involves purchasing or moving supplies to various sites, picking up/delivering food, clean up, etc.	
2. Assist/ manage volunteers at service projects and/or kid's camps.
