HOW TO REGISTER





- Complete an [Urban REAP Education Inquiry Form](#) with more information about your group and interests.
- We will send an email within 2-3 business days following up on your inquiry. If you don't hear from us, please email urbanreapdirector@missionwaco.org.
- Please pay 24 hours before your program begins. Each time slot is first come, first served. In the case of multiple inquiries for the same time slot, we will ask for you to secure your program through payment.

PROGRAM OPTIONS

Here are a few guidelines for all of our programs:

- Programs available for ages 5+. If you have a group of grade-school students, we ask that you send 1 adult for every 10 students.
- We request a minimum of 5 participants for any program, max 40 participants.
- We are in an outdoor setting, so please dress accordingly. We will have water available, but we encourage you to bring your own water as well! In the case of inclement weather, we will either reschedule or refund
